
#### Tank evacuation

Pumping chemicals or sewage from the bottom of an elevated tank . e.g. on a truck.




#### **Mixing**

When used without a dis-charge pipe, the pump can also be used to keep the liquid within the tank in motion.




#### Sump drain

The pump may be used to drain a pit when leakage has occurred or evacuate in case of emergency.



#### Pit Drainage

Suction of sewage or chemicals from the bottom of a pit



#### **Pumping**

For high foaming media the pump can deliver the clean liquid from the bottom of the pit



## **Technical Details**

#### Seperating disc:


#### **Ceramics to separate**

In conjunction with the liquid guidance the separating disc prevents the formation of air pockets and generates no magnetic losses

## A jacketed metallic screw combines the durability of the plastic with the stability of the metal. The connection is sealed by an O-ring between the screw and the nut

#### SiC for maximum service life

Extremely high resistance to abrasion and higher resistance to thermal shock than other ceramics. The SiC shaft is the ideal design for long service life

#### Made by injection molding


Glass fiber reinforced polypropylene with injection molded magnets and plain bearings made of carbon fiber reinforced PTFE. The best combination for this purpose

#### Checking direction of rotation:

#### Only start absolutely immersed

The motor can rotate in the wrong direction after electrical connection. Therefore it is necessary to check the direction of rotation and if necessary to change it. A wrong direction of rotation is among other things to recognize that the pump only reaches about 60% of the capacity and the absorbed current is too low. Proceed as shown below:

Start and stop the pump immediately while it hangs from a rope in a container of water (Figure 1). When looking from the top of the pump, the pump must turn counterclockwise. Then the direction of rotation of the motor is correct. When checking the direction of rotation, make sure that the pump presses fluid when it starts up from the discharge port and that this fluid could cause injuries.



#### **Performance Curve**




